## Rule and Regulation for Trial match (Under 19 Girls Players) Organised by Meghalaya Cricket Association from the 30<sup>th</sup> of June to 9<sup>th</sup> July 2024 at Jagiroad Ground Assam

Apart from the normal laws of cricket, Association approved the following additional rules and regulation for the smooth and proper conduct of the trial matches:

- Proper dress code i.e., White dress / T-shirt with collar/trouser/socks/white sneakers/white boots should be worn by the players.
- 2. Team should report at least 45 minutes before the schedule start of and offer themselves for verification.
- 3. Matches will be of 50 overs a side.

Schedule of play:

Breakfast -8.15 am

**Toss-8.45** am

**Frist Session**-9.15 am to 12.45 pm (including 2 drinks break of maximum 5 minutes each after completion of 17<sup>th</sup> and 34<sup>th</sup> overs)

Lunch Break-12.45pm to 01.25 pm

**Second Session**- 01.25 pm to 4.35 pm (including 2 drinks break of maximum 5 minutes each after completion of 17<sup>th</sup> and 34<sup>th</sup> overs)

- 4. MCA will depute observers for the match i.e., Selectors, Coaches Umpires/Scorers/Officials etc.
- 5. Instructions given by the Observers/ Coaches in the ground should be strictly followed by the players.
- 6. Transportation shall be arranged by MCA from Polo to Jagiroad and back.

- 7. Reporting time at Polo will be 5am and the buses to depart at 5.30 am sharp. Please note anyone not reaching in time at Polo ground will have to make their own arrangement to be within reporting time at Jagiroad ground.
- 8. Discipline and decorum on and off the field should be maintained by all the players which also shall be noted for the selection process
- 9. Management shall have the right to amend or modify any of the rules as and when necessary in the interest of their selection process and the decision of the selectors shall be final and binding.
